TIPS

- · Attach two lengths of silver foil tape along top of 1D
- Dovetail bottom of 1D
- Using Pomegranate and Pixie inks, stamp "Hugs & Kisses" sentiment on 1D $\,$
- · Embellish card using pink enamel gems as desired

TIPS

- · Using Poppy ink, stamp large ampersand image on 2B
- Using black ink, stamp "Mr." and "Mrs." sentiments on either side of large ampersand, overlapping slightly
- Attach two lengths of silver foil tape along bottom of 2C $\,$
- · Embellish card using pink enamel gems as desired
