
TIPS

- Use White Daisy cardstock as base
- Use zip strip as piece B
- · Attach D using 3-D foam tape
- Dovetail bottom of E
- Using Peacock ink, stamp "family" onto scrap piece of Glacier cardstock; cut out and attach over E using 3-D foam tape.
- Using Peacock ink, stamp "the little things mean the most" onto page as shown
- Using Peacock ink, stamp flower stems onto page as shown; use masking technique to alter the stem lengths
- Using Goldrush ink, stamp base flowers as shown, using second generation stamping technique; then stamp on shade flowers



- \cdot Use White Daisy cardstock as base
- Use zip strip as piece F
- Using the same stamping technique as before, stamp flowers onto page as shown
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Attach B and C using 3-D foam tape
- Using Peacock ink, stamp "Count Your Blessings" above D as shown
